Frequently asked question (FAQ)

Q.1 Which course is provided by the college?

Ans. RSLW provides B.A.,LL.B (five year integrated course)

Q.2 What is the admission policy?

Ans. The candidate must have completed 10+2 examination with –
Minimum 50% for General Category
Minimum 45% for ST/SC Category

Q.3 Is the college approved by Bar Council of India?

Ans. Yes. RSLW is approved by the Bar Council of India.

Q.4 Whether it is a co-educational college?

Ans. No. The college is exclusively for women established in order to extend the outreach of women's education.

Q.5 Is there any entrance test?

Ans. Students seeking admission in RSLW must undergo any entrance test whether it may be RULET, CLAT or Entrance Test conducted by the college itself.

Q.6 What is the duration of course?

Ans. Duration of course will be 5 years (10 semester).

Q.7 What is the fee structure for course?

Ans. Rs. 40,000/- per semester for the session 2019-20.

Q.8 What is the college timings?

Ans. Classes timings – 9am to 2.30pm.

Q.9 Whether hostel facility is provided by the college?

Ans. Yes. In house facility is available for students, rooms are available on sharing basis.

Q.10 Whether AC rooms are available in hostel?

Ans. Yes. AC rooms are available for students in Hostel.

Q.11 Is there any uniform in the college?

Ans. To maintain discipline, the college has prescribed professional dress code for the students.

Q.12 What is the exam pattern?

Ans. Exam will be conducted on semester basis i.e. likely to be held in the month of December and June.

Q.13 Does the college provide any practical training for developing advocacy skills?

Ans. Yes college organises multiple events in order to enhance the advocacy skills like Moot Court Competition, client counselling, drafting, pleading in order to inculcate practical learning.

Q.14 Whether college provide any assistance for internships?

Ans. Yes. College provide assistance for internships and for this college has its association with NGO's, law firms, district court, high court, supreme court.

Q.15 What are the job opportunities after B.A.,LL.B?

Ans. A law graduate can be a law officer, legal assistance, legal advisor in any area of business requirement. She will be preferred for posts in banks, companies, railways and other central/state government officer, LPO's, academics etc. She can also appear in judicial examination.
